Called Meeting to Order. Linda Sielken called the meeting to order.

Opening Prayer. Randy provided the opening prayer.

Approval of Minutes. Prior committee minutes of June 11, 2024 were approved without comment.

Mission, Service, and Justice Report. Linda Sielken

- Bags were stuffed for migrants.
- Art supplies were given to Amado Youth Center and we were thanked profusely for them.

Treasurer's Report. Rick Irvin

- Purchased TV monitor that will not be moved around as much.
- No unusual expenses for June or July, \$35K ahead for July
- The undesignated cash position of the church is just under \$200K

Finance Team Report. Richard Himbury

- Volunteer audit team of 4 members will be working on auditing in the next 2-3 mos.
- Scholarship gift of \$500 given to Dominique Hill.
- Approved Samaritans in buying used van for a variety of purposes for \$4500-Samaritans will pay \$3K and \$1500 will come from reserved account
- 4 new tellers were recruited by Linda Sielken

Facilities and Scouts. No report due to Dennis's absence.

Old Business. None to report

New Business.

- John Merrill (representing The Worship and Music Committee) recommended these changes to the former (2020) JOB DESCRIPTION of Choir Director:
 - 1. Change title from Choir Director to Music Director- Traditional Service
 - 2. Education DMA instead of PHD. We're not sure why PHD had been used.

- 3. Eliminated the COVID-19 accommodations
- 4. Suggesting the addition of: "Working with the Worship and Music Committee...in two sections; preparing the annual budget and Annual Report and review of major pieces and concerts.
- 5. We've added, "and arranges for compensation" to the section, Recruits paid"Staff Singers"
- Recommended changes to last year's CONTRACT are:
 - 1. Change of job title from Choir Director to Music Director- Traditional Service
 - 2. Date of update to contract
 - 3. Mengda was making \$16,680 last year. We're suggesting a 2.5% increase to \$17,100
 - 4. For purpose of her WORK VISA (a requirement) we've added the sentence, "This is a 20 hour per week, ..."
- Rick moved to approve changes and it was carried unanimously.
- Amy recommends any new hire go through the personnel committee.
- Leslie DeGrassi is reorganizing the homepage of the church's website, and our live-streaming platform. It will soon be on You-Tube, but will be found on the homepage of the website. She is also working on the "Giving" page. Randy would like some mention or symbol of our "Open and Affirming" status on the front page.
- ellie would like to see closed captioning both on live-streaming and in the sanctuary during services.
- An electrical event took out the church's router, phone, internet, and sound system. All
 but the sound system were restored and Larry is working with CPAC (since they have
 the same system) to determine what was damaged in the sound system. Amy reported
 a stronger surge protector was installed in hopes of preventing this outage from
 happening again.
- Kathy Babcock brought forth the need to coordinate ushers for the second service, and it was suggested that "feelers be put out" to find volunteers.
- Karen Martin has made cards and would like to sell them during the mission fair.
- Dennis reports that new flooring in the Redman Room will take place Sept. 14 and 15.
